FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to achieve a total return on your investment, through a combination of capital growth and income on the Fund's assets, which reflects the return of the iBoxx MSCI ESG SRI EUR Corporates Index ("Index").
- The Fund invests in fixed income (FI) securities (such as bonds) which predominantly make up the Index (which comprises corporate bonds) and comply with the index provider's socially responsible investment ("SRI") requirements and/or environmental, social and governance ("ESG") requirements and other eligibility criteria. - The Benchmark Index applies the EU Paris-aligned Benchmark Exclusions

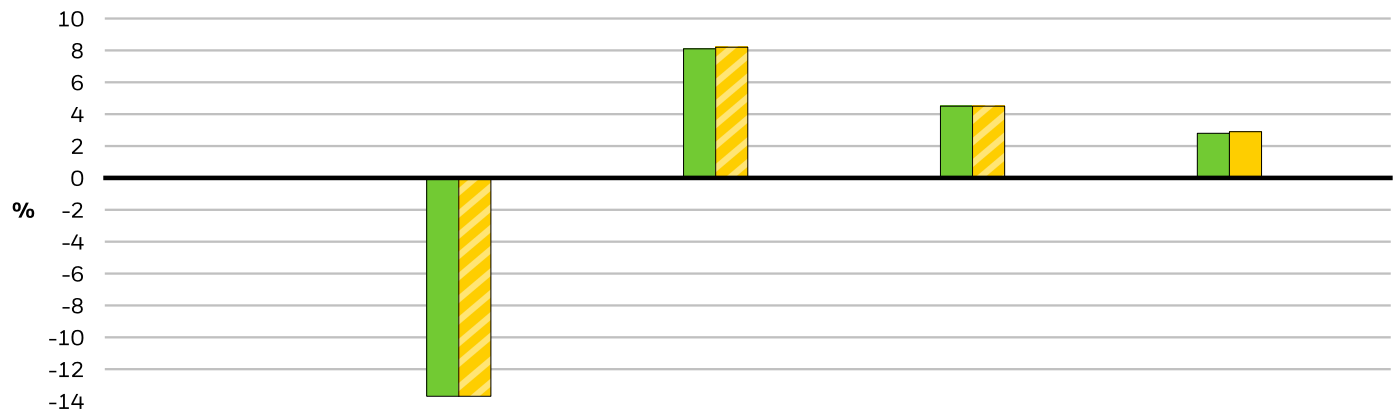
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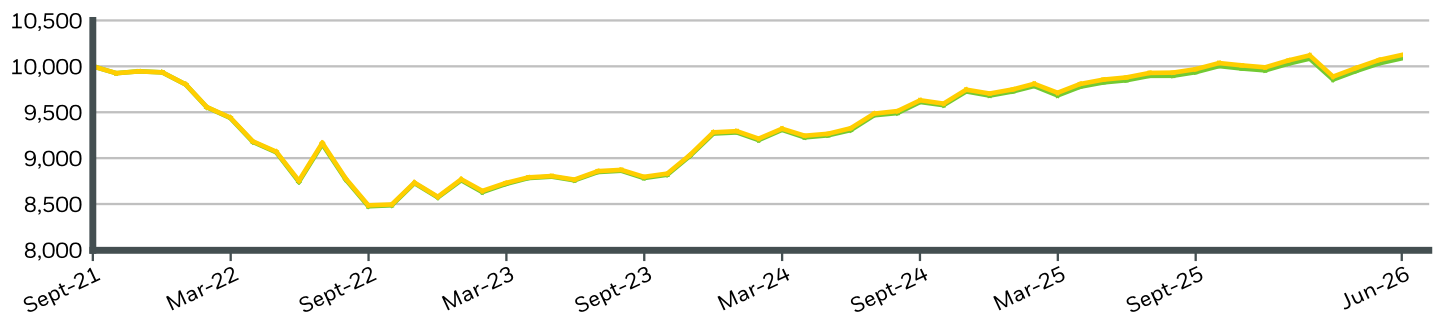
CALENDAR YEAR PERFORMANCE

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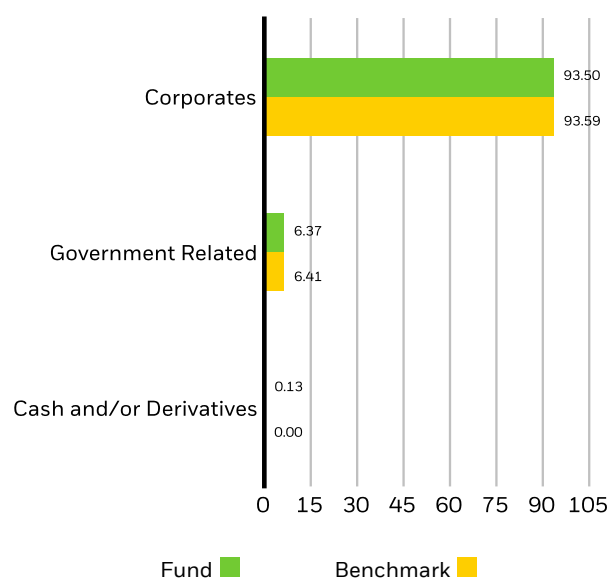

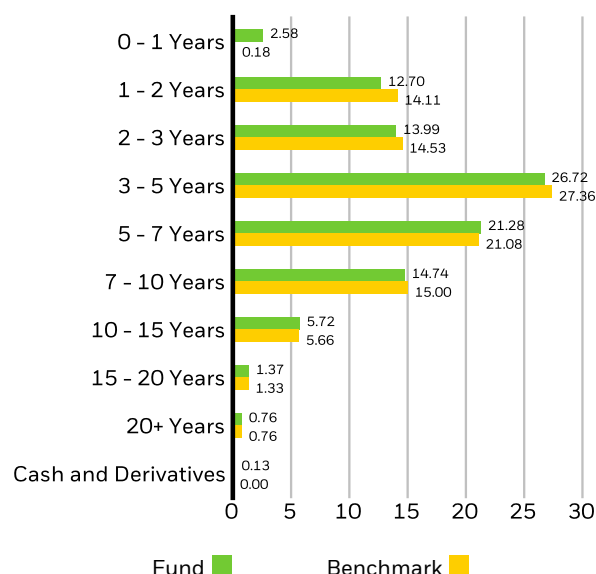

SECTOR BREAKDOWN (%)



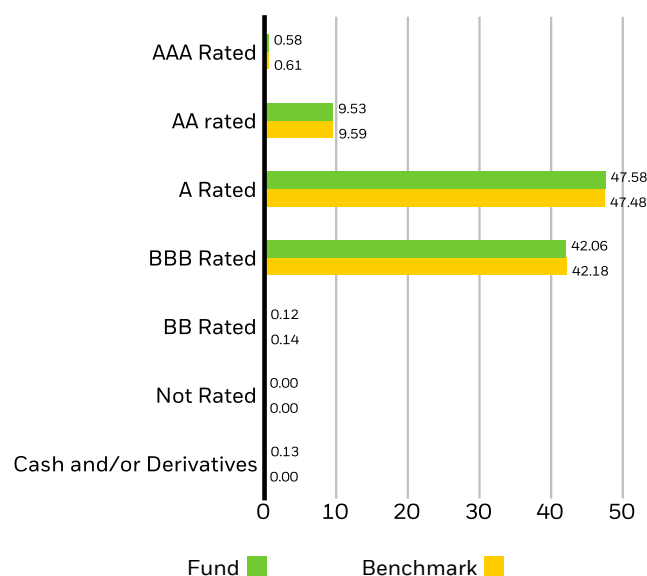

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GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices.

Article 9: Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Analyst Driven %ⁱ is the analyst input into the overall rating assignment, including direct analyst coverage and inheritance of an analyst-rated pillar

Yield to Maturity: Yield to Maturity (YTM) is the discount rate that equates the present value of bond's cash flows with its market price (including accrued interest). The fund YTM is the weighted average of fund's individual bond holding YTM's based upon Net Asset Value ('NAV'). The measure does not include fees and expenses. For callable bonds, YTM is the Yield-to-Worst.

Effective Duration: Effective duration is a measure of a fund's interest-rate sensitivity. Put simply, the longer a fund's duration, the more sensitive the fund is to shifts in interest rates. So a fund with a duration of 10 years is twice as volatile as a fund with a five-year duration.
