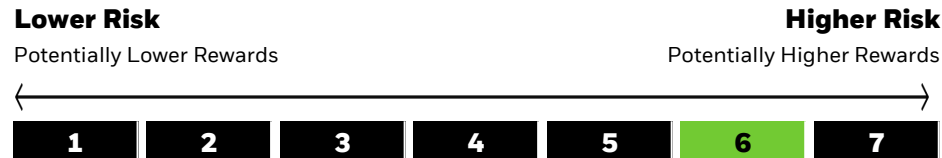
FUND OVERVIEW

The Fund aims to achieve a return on your investment through a combination of capital growth and income by tracking the performance of the STOXX UK Domestic Focus Index.

KEY BENEFITS

- 1. The Index is comprised of companies that generate at least 50% of their revenues domestically within the STOXX UK All Cap Index region. To remain in the Index, companies are required to continue generating at least 45% of their revenues domestically within the region.
- 2. The Index is free float-adjusted and market capitalisation weighted and is rebalanced on a semi-annual basis.
- 3. The Fund seeks to replicate the Index by directly holding the equity securities that make up the Index in similar proportions

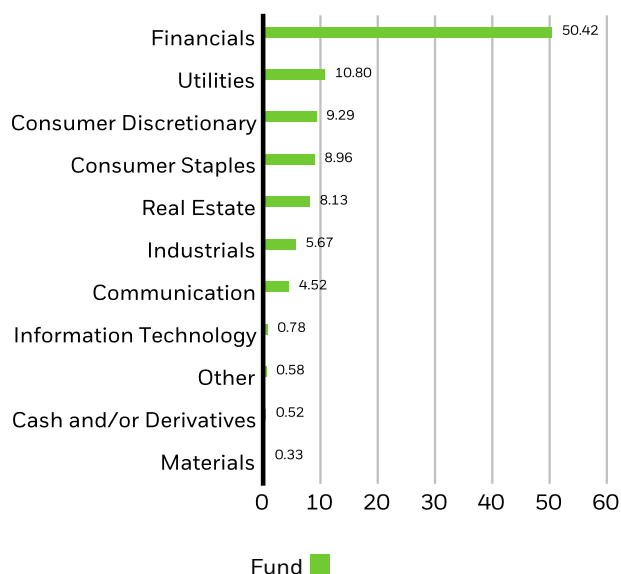
