### Annual Shareholder Report — February 28, 2026

#### How did the Fund perform last year?

- For the reporting period ended February 28, 2026, the Fund returned 7.09%.
- For the same period, the Bloomberg U.S. Aggregate Index returned 6.53%, the BlackRock Investment Grade Systematic Bond Index returned 7.29% and the Markit iBoxx USD Liquid Investment Grade Index returned 6.82%.

#### What contributed to performance?

U.S. bond markets gained during the reporting period, supported by a resilient domestic economy despite conflicting data. The Federal Reserve (“Fed”) reduced rates by 75 basis points across three 25 basis point rate cuts in late 2025, prompted by a cooling labor market amid elevated inflation. The yield curve (the difference between a shorter-term bond and a longer-term bond, most often gauged by the two-year Treasury note and the 10-year Treasury note) continued to steepen as rate cuts pushed shorter-term yields lower, while inflation and heavy Treasury supply kept longer-maturity yields higher. Against this backdrop, credit markets remained well supported, with investment grade and high yield spreads tightening to near the lower end of their historical ranges, reflecting resilient fundamentals, healthy demand for income, and a constructive growth outlook. Issues rated on the lower end of investment grade by Moody’s meaningfully added to the Fund’s return. By sector, consumer non-cyclical, energy, and financial bonds supported performance. Issues rated investment grade Baa by Moody’s added meaningfully to returns. By maturity, bonds between seven and ten years, and those over ten years, contributed the most.

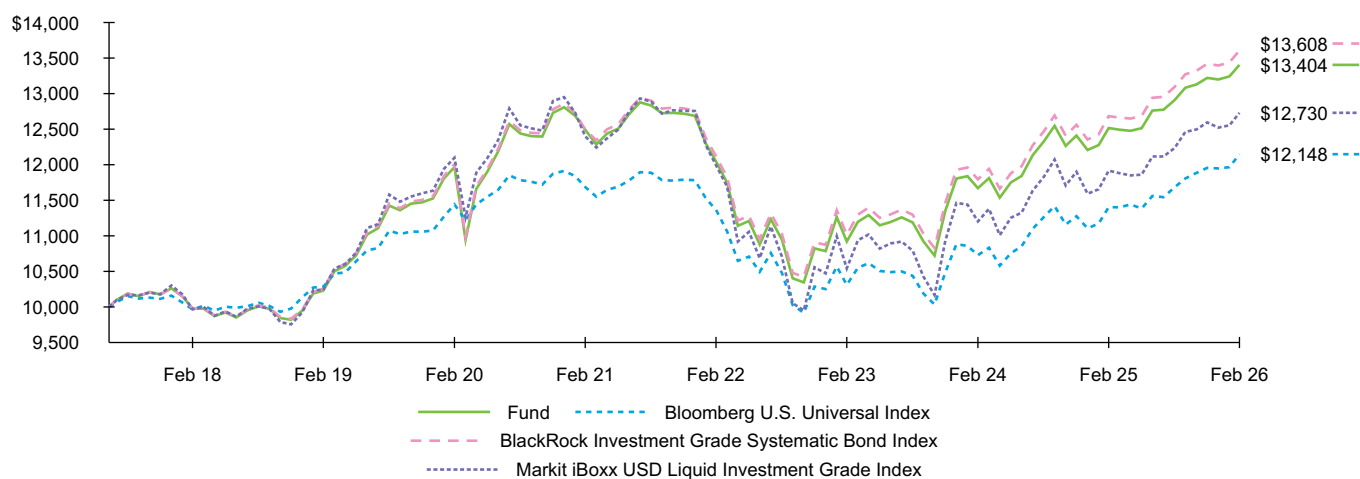
#### What detracted from performance?
