IQQ's low share price makes the Nasdaq-100 easily accessible for all investors.¹



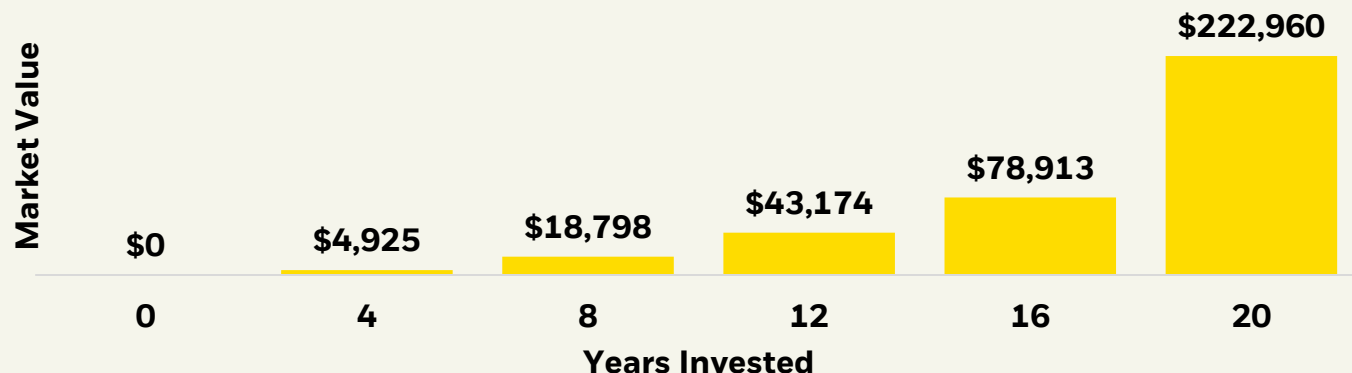
